

## What is IB?

- "IB" is short for "International Baccalaureate"
- It is a **two-year program** that begins in a student's junior year.
- International program of studies for students who want to challenge themselves academically by taking a range of courses that follow a 1 and 2 year progression.



### What are the benefits of IB?

- Wholistic approach to education and academics
- A tight-knit community that grows together
- Opportunities for Bright Futures and other Scholarships and Awards
- IB Students are highly **sought after** by colleges and universities
- Opportunity to achieve **college credit**
- Academics focused on **college preparedness**



# How does my child prepare for success in the IB?

- Take prerequisite courses!
  - Algebra 2 Honors (Recommended for DP)
  - Foreign Language (Recommended for DP)
  - CTE Pathway (Required for CP)
- Time Management




- Amount of homework per week varies by class, teacher and student. Be prepared to have homework weekly.
- IB Assessments are largely reading and writing based.
  - Essay writing is required in every class. Strong writing skills are recommended.

## **Other Prerequisites**



- 3.0 GPA, unweighted
- Passing Score of 3 on ELA FAST Assessment
- Must be in good standing with Attendance and Discipline
- Rising Juniors are eligible to apply!

#### Diploma Program (DP)



- Full IB Course Schedule
- Waived from certain FL Graduation Requirements
- IB Diploma Core
  - Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
    - Extended Essay
    - Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)



#### **Career Program (CP)**



- A Career-Related Study
- Must take all FL Graduation Requirements
- A minimum of **two** IB Courses
- IB Career Core
  - Personal and Professional Skills (PPS)
    - Language Development
    - Reflective Project
    - Service Learning



#### <u>Career Pathways</u>

- Medical
- Engineering
- Business
- Computer Science
- Digital Design
- Digital Media
- ROTC
- Music


