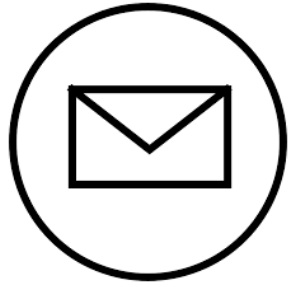

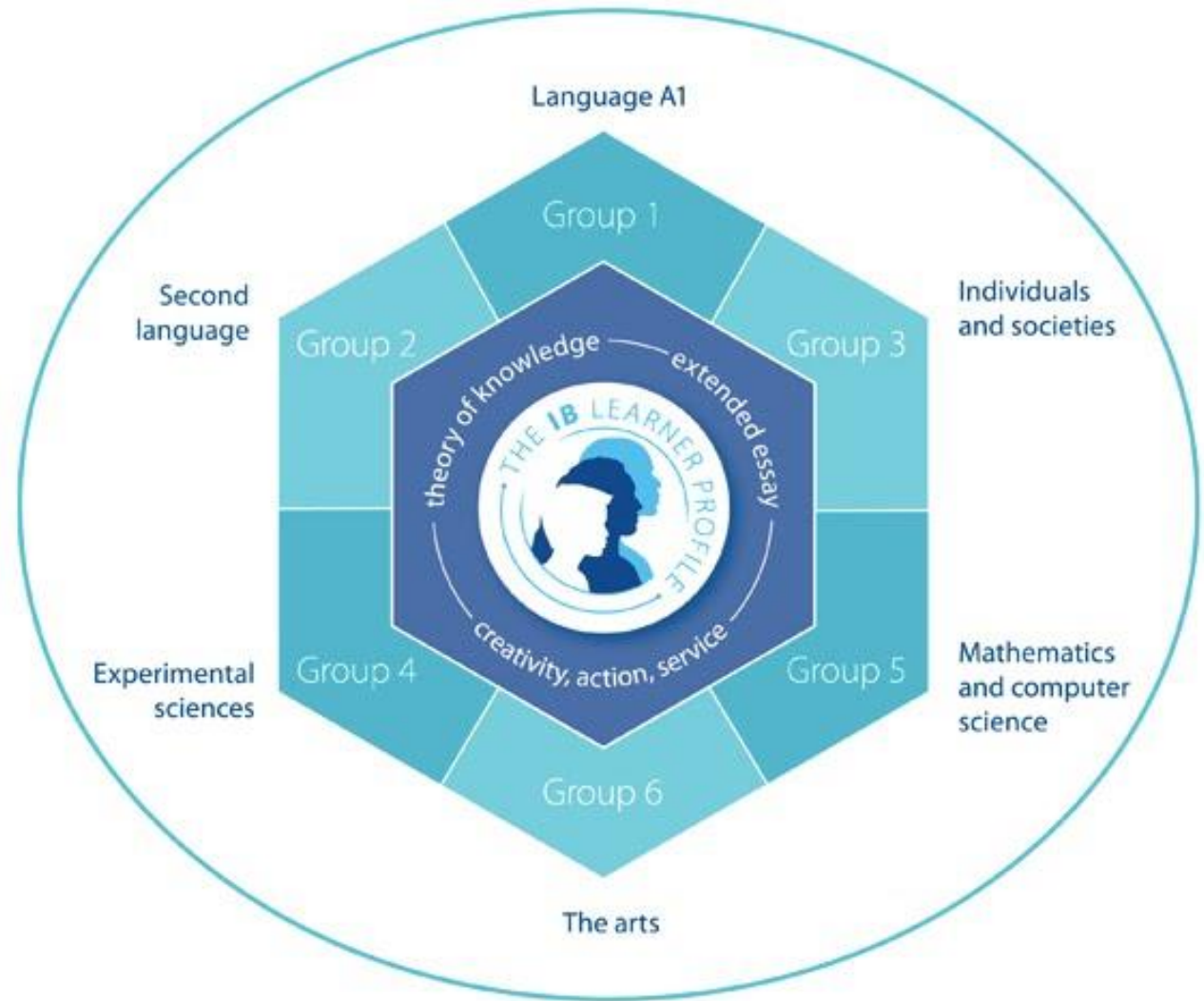

How to earn the IB Diploma (DP)

- The candidate earns 24 or more points
 - No grade 1 awarded in a subject/level
 - No more than **TWO** grade 2's awarded (HL or SL)
 - No more than **THREE** grade 3's or below awarded (HL or SL)
 - 12 points or more on HL subjects (candidates who register for four HL subjects the three **HIGHEST** grades count)
 - 9 point or more on SL subjects (candidates who register for four HL subjects must gain **AT LEAST** 5 points at SL)
 - Satisfactory completion of the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge (IB score of D or higher)
 - No score of E or N in any subject
 - CAS requirements met

- **Reflective Project** score of a D
 - Written essay on an ethical dilemma within their career field
 - 50 hours
